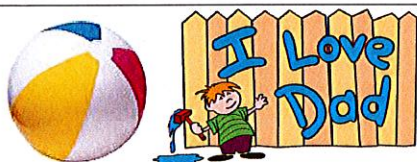


The Preschool Press June 2017

Reminders from the preschool Office:

Shoes

With the weather getting warmer we are seeing more and more sandals with out back straps on the children. Although we do not have a rule that says no flip-flops or shoes with out straps we do **prefer** that all shoes have back straps so that the shoe is secured to the foot. Flip-flops and sandals without straps tend to fall off easier and children tend to get hurt, especially when they are on the playground.

Sprinkler Days

The center will have a sprinkler day every Wednesday. Please send a **one-piece** swimsuit, for your girl, or a pair of swim trunks for your boy, and a towel that can be left at the center. Please be sure to clearly label your child's swimwear and towel as we will be washing them and we want to make sure they get back to the proper child. Children are encouraged to bring water shoes to wear. Any child that does not have water shoes will play in the water bare foot.

This is a great time for dads or the person playing that role to come in and have breakfast with their child/children.
