Bible Scope and Sequence

Kindergarten – 5th Grade Summit – Building on the Rock -*Building on the Rock* is the first fully integrated worldview and Bible survey course for elementary school students. This unique curriculum is designed to help younger students begin to formulate and relate learned Bible facts with a genuine Christian worldview, while laying the groundwork for later comparative worldview studies.

6th Grade – 8th Grade Discipleship – Becoming true followers of Christ.

During these three years topics such as salvation, God's word, prayer, baptism and witnessing are the main focus. They will learn the importance of making decisions to remain pure in the face of an immoral culture. Students are taught how to study the Bible as they grow spiritually strong. In a time when people are searching to fill the hungry places in their souls, students are brought into the study of Christ, the bread of life, to satisfy their longings. As students grow and deepen their relationship with Christ through discipleship, they will be taught how to communicate the Gospel, handle excuses given by people for rejecting the Gospel, and how to stand strong in their faith.

9th Grade – 10th Grade Advanced What The Bible Is All About

11th Grade – 12th Grade Worldview / Comparative Religions
